

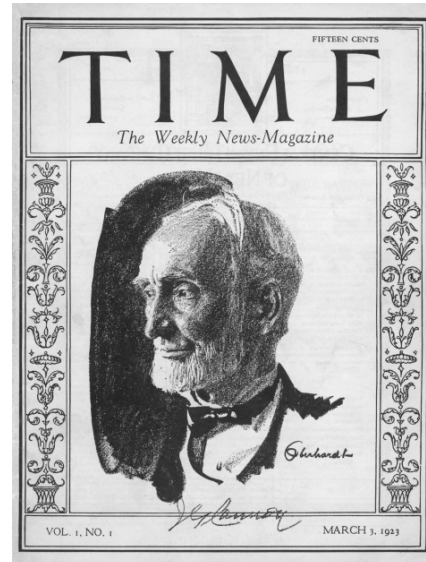

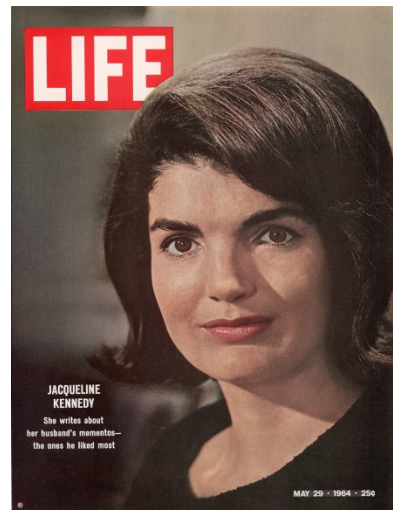
Time Inc. founders Briton Hadden and Henry Luce, detail from photo of the Yale News Board, 1920.



TIME's first cover, featuring "Uncle Joe" Cannon, Speaker of the House of Representatives, by William Oberhardt, March 3, 1923.

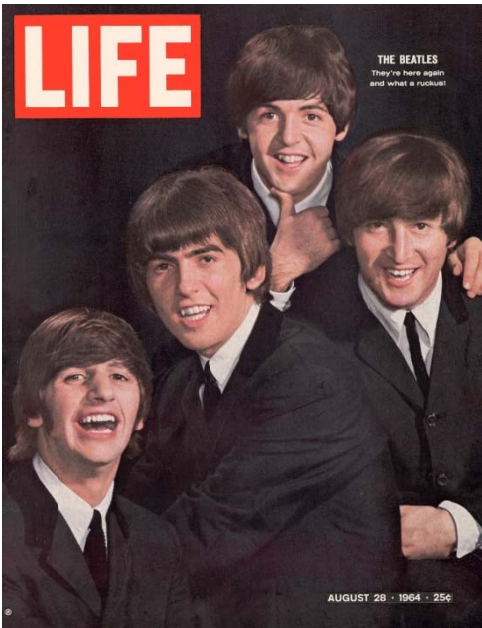


A vintage publicity photo of a March of Time newsreel, being screened in Radio City Music Hall, 1938.



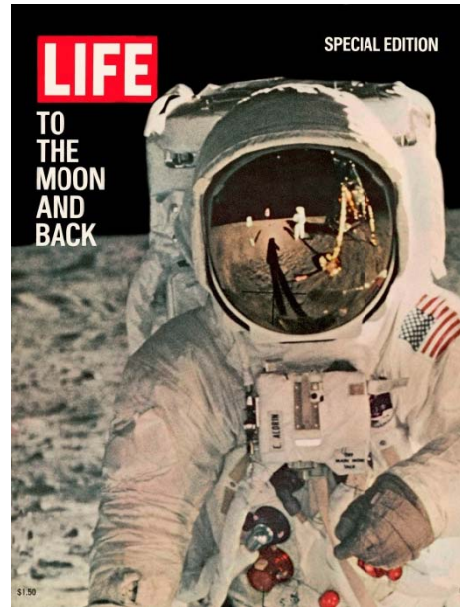
LIFE Magazine May 29, 1964 Cover.

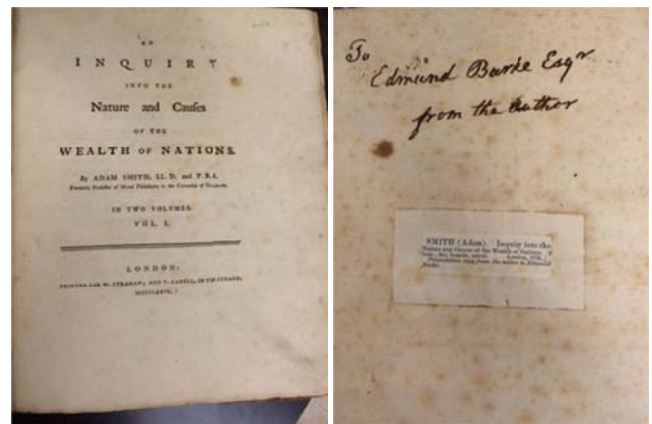
